

Diploma in Nautical Studies (DNS)

Entry Requirement:

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT - IGCSE O' Level or any other equivalent qualification.

Required Minimum of 5 (Five) Credits:

 Credit in Mathematics, Science/ Technical, 3 other subjects and credit in English language.

General Requirements

- Single, aged between 18 and 25 years of age
- Must be physically and mentally fit as certified by medical practitioner approved by Malaysia Marine Department
- Minimum height of 158cm and weight of 48kg for male applicants (BMI: 18.5 -24.9)
- Minimum height of 155cm and weight of 42kg for female applicants (BMI: 18.5-24.9)
- Not colour blind
- Good eyesight (visual acuity of 6/6)

Diploma in Marine Engineering (DME)

Entry Requirement:

INTERNATIONAL STUDENT - IGCSE O' Level or any other equivalent qualification.

Required Minimum of 5 (Five) Credits:

 Credit in Mathematics, Science/ Technical, 3 other subjects and credit in English language.

General Requirements

- Single, aged between 18 and 25 years of age
- Must be physically and mentally fit as certified by medical practitioner approved by Malaysia Marine Department
- Minimum height of 158cm and weight of 48kg for male applicants (BMI: 18.5 -24.9)
- Minimum height of 155cm and weight of 42kg for female applicants (BMI: 18.5-24.9)
- Not colour blind
- Good eyesight (visual acuity of 6/6) (if with optical aid power should not exceed 200)



VISA APPLICATION PROCESS AND PROCEDURES

STEP 1:

Student submit documents for visa application

Required documents for Visa Application:

- 1. One (1) copy of Passport (all pages) and One (1) set in softcopy
- 2. Passport data page (bio-data)
- 3. All pages with Visa information
- 4. Observation page (showing any extensions, clarifications of name, and previous passport numbers)
- 5. Recommended passport **minimum** validity of **24** months
- 6. Special Pass or Exit Stamp (if applicable)
- 7. Two (2) copies of the Academic Transcripts, completion letter and relevant certificates, and One (1) set in softcopy
- 8. Four (4) passport size photographs with WHITE background (35mm x 45mm), and One (1) set in softcopy

STEP 2:

Application checked and documents verified by ALAM. Visa Processing Fee total of RM3,580 (non-refundable) to be paid upon receiving the Eligibility Letter (EL) issued by ALAM.

Visa Processing Fee total of RM3,580 inclusive of:

- 1. EMGS Visa Processing Fee
- 2. Medical Screening (Health Declaration Form)
- 3. International Students Fee
- 4. eVAL Processing Fee
- I-Kad /Student Pass
- 6. Medical Insurance (per annum) EMGS
- 7. Application and Registration Fee



VISA APPLICATION PROCESS AND PROCEDURES (CONTINUED)

STEP 3:

Visa Approved

After the VAL (Visa Approval Letter) is approved, student will be notified to make the remaining payment fee of RM3,620 together with 1st year tuition fee.

Once the payment is received, the e-VAL will be emailed to the student.

The student then can proceed to the Malaysian Embassy in their respective country for Visa stamping for a Single-Entry Visa (SEV).

Fee total of RM3,620 inclusive of:

- Visa Security Deposit (Campus Facilities Usage- Security Deposit)
- 2. Special Administration Fee (On-Time Fee)
- 3. Pass Endorsement (per annum)

VISA APPLICATION PROCESS AND PROCEDURES (CONTINUED)

POST MEDICAL

New international students are required to attend a post medical screening at a EMGS panel clinic in Malaysia within 7 working days of their arrival date.

Important note: without undergo/ fail the medical screening at EMGS panel clinic within the time period, EMGS will not be able to issue the supporting letter and Malaysia immigration also will not process the student pass endorsement.

TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- Fee structure is subject to change without prior notice
- Visa process and procedure subject to change if any new regulation set by the government



FAQ - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

Question: How the Student check their eligibility

Answer:

Submit the completed application form online application together with academic qualifications, for evaluation and advice on the student's eligibility.

Once Eligibility Letter is issued, the student is required to pay the visa fees (as per fee structure)

Question: ALAM English Placement Test (EPT)

Answer:

Students who are from non-English speaking countries who do not have English passes must take the English Placement Test (EPT). This test is conducted to measure the student's current English proficiency.

Students who score below the accepted level are then required to attend the Certificate in Intensive English Programme (CIE).

If your English proficiency is at an acceptable level at ALAM, you do not have to enroll in the CIE Programme. Certificate in Intensive English Program is only for Diploma Level students.

Question: Can students work part-time?

Answer:

ALAM strictly does not allow students to do any Part-time Job as this is in accordance to the rules of Student Visa/ Malaysian Immigration.

Question: Any age limit for admission after graduating from High School?

Answer:

There is up to 25 years old age limit for Diploma program in ALAM



FAQ - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (CONTINUED)

Question: Application Form (International Admission) Certified True Copy (any particular authority) certification needed?

Answer:

Certification can be done by any government officer, school teacher, principal or they can approach the embassy as well. Original documents must be presented when they register at the Institution for verification. If any documents are forged, the Institution will declare the student's admission null and void.

Question: English language proficiency, is it compulsory?

Answer:

Yes, it is.

Question: Accommodation, does the student have a choice to stay outside the campus?

Answer:

ALAM will advise further to the students on the room's availability. Despite the fact that we have a full regimental system and that staying on campus is required for cadetship and rating students, there are other housing options available inside the campus, including villa rooms and regular dorms.

Question: What are the charges for single room and shared room?

Answer:

Subject to the availability of the unit and type of accommodation units.



FAQ - ADDITIONAL INFORMATION (CONTINUED)

Question: Applications are subject to be approved by Malaysian Ministry of Higher Education, Immigration and local bodies, what can be reason for possibility of rejection. In case of such rejection will ALAM refund fees paid if any?

Answer:

Rejections can happen due to medical reasons or confusing information such as different names in different certificates (birth certificate, passport, academic certificates). Only the refundable amount can be refunded as stipulated in our refund policy.

ALAM will decide on admission as per entry requirements set by the Ministry of Education and the University's internal policy. Therefore, there will not be any case of rejection after initial academic acceptance.

On visa application rejection, all conditions for such rejection are solely the decision of Malaysian Immigration Department who will scrutinize every application.

Question: ALAM will assist on the dependent pass for the spouse/ family members?

Answer: ALAM will not be responsible for the dependent pass application.

Question: Airport clearance will be done by ALAM?

Answer: Yes, it is.

Question: How does the Regimental System integrate with Cadetship, Business Management and Ratings

Answer:

The Regimental system is part of the Cadetship and Ratings programs. In the Business and Management faculty, partial regimentation is implemented
